Car Parking 2018



A limited number of car parking spaces are available in the Church yard for the use and convenience of members and associates.

The Church Finance and Property committee draw your attention to the following conditions :-

1. It is suggested that the minimum contribution for Casual Users should be **£25.00** per annum.
2. It is suggested also that the minimum charge to Commercial Users should be £2.00 per day.
3. Parking Permits will normally run from January to December each year. Permits which are issued during the year will expire on 31st December.
4. The issue of a Parking Permit will not impose any liability on the Church for damages sustained to the vehicle or loss which may be incurred whilst parking at the church premises
5. A Parking Permit cannot, unfortunately, guarantee a parking space in the car park.
6. Please park tidily in the car park—giving due consideration to other users. If you have to cause an obstruction for a short period whilst you are in the premises—leave a note on your dash so that you can be contacted.
